

# Colored Jules

## Large Triangle Shawl

---



### Description

A very simple large wrap made using large needles so it knits up quickly. The one in the picture uses two different colored skeins of wool, knitting two rows from one and two from the other. Knitted in plain garter stitch – no purl.

### Materials

15mm needles.  
2 x 100gms Colored Jules Hand Dyed Boucle Mohair  
– 400 meters

**Tension** Not important



### Tips

If you have hanks or skeins of wool, wind them into balls first. Alternate between the two balls by knitting two rows from one ball and then two rows from the other. Carry the yarn loosely up the side of your knitting or wrap the yarn over the last stitch of the second row. Why two rows – you'll soon see!

Also if you put an elastic band over the end of one needle you will easily be able to tell which row you are increasing on.

### Pattern

Cast on 5 stitches.

Using plain knitting or garter stitch (no purl):

Increase at beginning and end of **each** row until you have 45 stitches.

Increase **each end of every second row only**.

Continue, until you reach the desired size or until you only have enough yarn left to cast off.

Cast off loosely and darn in ends.
